## **Submission Guidelines**

Kosmos Institute is dedicated to *making philosophy fun again*. We value freedom in intellectual inquiry and expression, and wish to support scholars by providing a field for the cross-pollination of ideas in a way that privileges the role of imagination in scholarship. As part of our ongoing efforts to maintain such support systems, we are launching the first of our publications—an online multi-media journal called *Garden of Noetic Arts*.

We are currently soliciting well-conceived and polished submissions. Submissions can take the form of writing, artwork, poems, videos, photography, graphic art, digital zine pages, animation, short graphic novels, cartoons, music, dance, mythopoesis, astrology readings, social or cultural criticism and/or analysis, and anything in between:

Writing—under 750 words. It is ignoble to quote without attribution but formal citations are not required.

Poetry—under two double-spaced pages.

Photos—2500px, min 500KB, max 1MB.

Video—under 5 minutes. Upload to YouTube and share link.

Music—under 5 minutes. Upload to SoundCloud or other free music streaming service and submit link.

Any medium not specified here can be discussed on an individual basis.

All work must be original. Although the definition of "original" continues to shift, we all know what it means. It means that you have the rights to all aspects of the artwork, or are using elements from the public domain.

Absolutely no Al-generated products unless necessary for the project and clearly identified as Al.

Title required. If the title is "Untitled" then subtitle with course attribution e.g. "Untitled: Alchemy East and West"

Our goal is to cultivate a unique, enduring, and refined garden together. Therefore, we ask that all submissions maintain high quality standards. Please ensure that your submissions are clean, clear, polished, and edited.

## **SUBMISSION DATES AND DEADLINES:**

Garden of Noetic Arts follows the chronology of Kosmos Institute courses and submissions must be related to the subject matters under study in the relevant quarter.

Submissions related to Spring 2024 classes—The Near-Death Experience and Alchemy East and West—are welcome FROM NOW UNTIL JUNE 22, 2024.
